

Tri-Employment Program

Tri-Employment program is for North Providence High School students who have an IEP and would benefit from work readiness training and integrated paid internships. This program is designed to engage youth, enhance their employment outcomes, and prevent drop-out. Students will complete weekly workshops during which they will learn more about their interests, preferences, aptitudes, and the skills needed to be successfully employed...And have fun! Interactive virtual workshops will take place one day per week via video conferencing.

Students can earn up to \$200 in Amazon gift cards for participation in these workshops! Following the work readiness workshops, students will complete an eight (8) week, ten (10) hours per week paid internship. Internship placements will be developed based on student interest areas and site availability (dependent on RIDE/DOH/ ORS guidelines).
